## Inaugural Bali Underwater Hockey Tournament 24-27 April 2015 Klub Jimbaran Sports Centre, Bali

To: All Australian and Indonesian Underwater Hockey Players,

We are happy to invite you to the Inaugural Bali Underwater Hockey Tournament 2015 hosted by the Western Australian Underwater Hockey Commission from 24 to 27 April 2015, at Klub Jimbaran Sports Centre in Jimbaran, Bali.

### **The Pool**

Klub Jimbaran has a 27m x 15m tiled pool which slopes from 1.2 m at the shallow end to 1.6 m at the deep end (like Margaret River pool but with tiles). It also has a number of warm-up areas on the side. NB There will not be official goal trays or time display equipment used at the tournament.

### **Tournament Format**

The Tournament is a two day tournament open to all skill levels with only one division which is mixed. There are spaces for a maximum of 30 Australian players and 10 Indonesian players – first in, best dressed.

Players will be drafted to form equal teams and each team will comprise a mixture of Australian and Indonesian players.

Deck (1) and water (2) referees will come from the teams.

### **Post-tournament Trip**

The tournament will be followed by an overnight dive/surf trip to the island of Lembongan (30 minute boat ride from Sanur). The return ferry ticket and overnight stay forms part of the tournament fee. We intend to book everyone on Scoot Cruises as they are cheap and they do pick up from Balangan Beach hotels and drop off to International Airport (or any other hotel).

Surfing and freediving at Nusa Lembongan only costs the fee of the local boat skipper that will drop you at the reef or break – between \$5 and \$20 depending on round trip time.

### **Preliminary Itinerary**

23 April	arrive in Bali
24 April	games between 2pm and 6pm sunset drinks and dinner at Jimbaran Bay Seafood Restaurant
25 April	games between 10am and 4pm Anzac Day drinks, awards ceremony and dinner at Potato Head Beach Club, Seminyak
26 April	8am pick up for 9:30am ferry to post tournament overnight trip to the island of Nusa Lembongan
27 April	12:30pm ferry to Bali and transfer to airport or elsewhere

A detailed itinerary will be released in March 2015

### **Tournament fee**

Tournament fee per player is \$300 and it includes:

- Accommodation at Balangan Beach (near Jimbaran) for 3 nights;
- Accommodation at Nusa Lembongan for 1 night;
- Return ferry ticket from Sanur to Nusa Lembongan (includes hotel pick up and airport drop off on departure of Bali);
- Seafood dinner at Jimbaran Bay on 24 April;
- Transport to and from pool and dinner venues on 24-25 April;
- Pool entry and line hire fees.

It does not include:

- Return flights to Bali (approximately \$400 from Perth at the moment);
- Airport arrival tax (\$35)
- Airport transfer to accommodation on arrival (\$10);
- Breakfast/lunch/dinner and drinks for 3-4 days (other than Jimbaran Bay Seafood dinner on 24 April) (\$150);
- Travel insurance (\$50);
- Airport departure tax (\$20).

A 100% refund of the tournament fee is offered for registrations cancelled on or before 1 March 2015.

A deposit of \$150 is required to confirm your registration. The final payment of \$150 is due by 1 March 2014.

Send Deposit and Final Payment to: Clare Gleeson BSB 086 061 Acc No 161 251 177. Please note the name(s) of players registering in the transaction and please email me if you intend to bring a partner/family/friend for accommodation and cost purposes.

This is a no-profit event so any leftover funds will be refunded to players.

### **Accommodation - Bali**

The two hotel options are both 2.5 star resorts at Balangan Beach. These options are next door to each other and on the cliff above Balangan Beach. Both offer accommodation at approximately \$35 per person night.

Balangan Beach is about 15 minutes drive to the pool. Jimbaran Bay is closer to the pool than Balangan Beach however accommodation is generally only 4 and 5 star at Jimbaran. Balangan Beach has the advantage of a nice surf break and chilled out atmosphere away from the crowds (and not many Aussies).

### **Accommodation – Nusa Lembongan**

The two hotel options in Nusa Lembongan are a 2.5 star resorts. Again, they are next door to each other and located on the water's edge. Accommodation is approximately \$35 per person per night.

### **Accommodation – alternative**

The price of the accommodation (and number of stars) is quite low however I have stayed at these options and in my opinion they are fine. The bathrooms don't always have hot running water but we will be showering at the pool most of the time anyway.

If you are not willing to stay in a 2.5 star option and want to organise your own accommodation, please let me know so that I can calculate a different tournament fee for you which excludes accommodation and transport arrangements.
